WHAT IS A PEO?

Professional employer organizations (PEOs) enable clients to outsource the management of human resources, employee benefits, payroll and workers' compensation.

HOW DO PEOs WORK?

PEOs will contractually assume administrative functions related to employees: payroll, benefits plan sponsorship and human resource compliance through a co-employment relationship.

This type of arrangement allows the employees of the client organization to enroll in larger benefit plans that may not otherwise be available to the PEO client. Employees experience no change in their employment relationship with the PEO client organization.

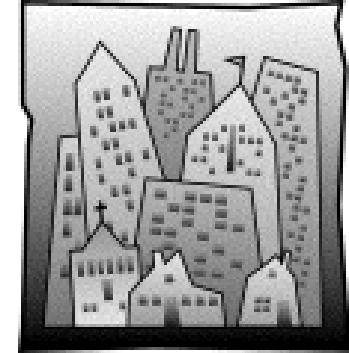
