- He is a distinguished entrepreneur, educator, and community leader based in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Born into poverty in Puerto Rico, he has dedicated his career to empowering underserved communities through entrepreneurship and education.
- Dr. Soler has founded multiple organizations, including the Multicultural Entrepreneurial Institute (MEI) and the Latino Chamber of Commerce of Southeastern Wisconsin.
- Under his leadership, these organizations have facilitated the formation of over 6,200 enterprises in Wisconsin and provided more than \$2.1 million in loans, grants, and technical assistance to at-risk businesses.
- He also serves as an adjunct faculty member at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee, teaching courses in entrepreneurship, accounting, nonprofit management, and marketing.
